Annual cum activity Report for the year ended 31st March 2000

What we are ?

Annai Therasa Samuga Sevai Sangam (ATSSS) is non-governmental Organisation , it is registered under Tamilnadu Society Act 1975 and bearing its Regd. No. 133/1997. Ours is a women organisation, 10 women activist run our society with its main focus of empowerment of Rural disadvantaged women since 1996.

Our areas of Operation:- (Tirukoilur Block)

Objectives of ATSSS:

- Active participation, collective response for the total development of Rural disadvantaged women and children.
- To Create socio, economical, political, Health and environmental awareness.
- To uplift the poor women and children through available local technology and community Resources and their self reliance thereby.
- To kindle village self confidence by helping the people to address their problems and betting on for basic amenities.
- Mobilization of Rural poor for compulsory education, as well eradication Of illiteracy by 10%
- To impart health and environmental understanding for the healthy rural environment.
- To strive for equalitarian society on the basis of our set out objectives we have done maximum developmental work with in our limitation.

- To make a social charge toward social order.
- Women's self reliance is our ultimate aim.

1. SHG Sangam Motivation Training

As we have done in the previous year of activities in formation of a strong and cohesive self help group and its follow-ups.

As a second phase, we have successfully stated the lending progress; inter group loan on reasonable interest rate and its revolving system. Proper trainings were imparted to all soughs. As per our strategically point of view and target achievement, we have to construct and another SHG at the same locality, in such a way 20 SHG of women's were formed and at the same time, we are monitoring, evaluating the existing women's groups. We have planned to construct hundred more groups by groups. We have planned to construct hundred more groups by 2000 and to be motivated by all the relevant technical injuts.

2. Youth Club Training:

Our society mobilized and organized the rural dalith youths and formed 10 youth organization in 9 villages. All the members were provided training planning, executing , evaluating their own project work without the external support. they were provided skill training in accounting and auditing their association accounts. Their personality is developed in order to participate in & social and political behaviors through our repeated trainings. through this training 200 rural youth club members were benefited.

3. SHG Skill Training:

Our society conducted this skill training to the chief functionaries of SHG's . bank officials, Leading NGO representatives were involved in this programme. they were given training in accounting , auditing and evaluating their our project work. Through this programme 30 chief functional were benefited.

4. Womens day celebration:

Womens day celebration was celebrated at our premises. About 250 women sangha members General public were the participants. Senior Advocate Mrs. Padmavathy, Womens Rotarians, local Panchayat leaders, Chairman of Tirukoilur Block were the Special invitee and chaired the function. All the participants were provided by a han a some luch and light refreshment. To derive the human resources, personal developments competitions in special taleuts, sporys, games activities, was conducted. Prizes was distributed to winner by the chairman of Mugaiyur block. Amudha and representatives of Rotarians. The programme was financially sponserd by the board members of ATSSS and the youth girls, youth men and elders of village were in charge of declaration and other helps in connection with the programme.

PRDP – Skill Training

Our Society conducted skill training in tailoring training for 7 girls with the financial support of District rural development agency. Each learners were provided Rs 350 per Month as stipend.

6. THADCO Skill Training:

Our society with the financial assistance conducted tailoring training programme for 10 educated rural poor girls. Each girls were provided an amount of Rs. 350 per month as stipend during this training period and they were also given training in cutting cloths, stitching and embroidering.

Conclusion:

Our society implemented its welfare programmes with the co-operation and support of Executive committee members and well wishers. Our welfare programmes will be continued in the forth coming year also.
